**Treasurer's Report:** current balance is £5.622, boosted by rent received for the GP's surgery. An invoice from Stephen Beardsley is outstanding.

**Correspondence:** letter sent to Kate Sampson about the works carried out to the path South of the North Glen Sannox picnic site. No reply yet received.

**Black Grouse Curry Night:** agreed that there should be a social event on 27 February to raise funds for the hall and the black grouse project (net proceeds to be split 50-50). There will be a meeting next week (Margo to circulate date when fixed) to agree precise format, who does what etc. It was also clarified that there is no intention to actually curry the grouse.

**Energy Saving Proposals:**

Bob Rooney is progressing this with a view to submitting the application for funding before 31 March. To achieve this responses to tenders will be needed for the meeting on 11 March. Jim Lees to discuss the schedule with Bob.

It was clarified that inclusion of the additional insulation work in the application will not commit us to proceeding but is necessary if we are to obtain grant funding.

**AOCB:**

- **Sign to Goat Fell:** concern was expressed that this is not sufficiently prominent for walkers to spot from the bus. The general feeling of the meeting was that it is the same as other similar signs around the island and that walkers climbing Goat Fell ought to be able to find their own way.
- **AGM:** agreed this should be deferred for a week until 11<sup>th</sup> March to ensure that all office bearers can attend.
- **Site Clearance at the Quarry:** Betty spoke of the problem of incessant noise at the site. John said that work was scheduled to continue for up to three years but hopefully once site clearance has finished noise will be reduced.
- **Hall Spring Clean:** this will be on Wed/Thurs 3/4 March. Hall will be open daytime and evening to freshen up the orange paintwork, spring clean the kitchen etc. Volunteers welcome.
- **ACVS:** a supply of leaflets is awaiting pick-up from the ACVS office in Lamlash.
- **Ferry:** Jim updated the meeting on the exploratory discussions between Western Ferries and the Ferry Committee.
